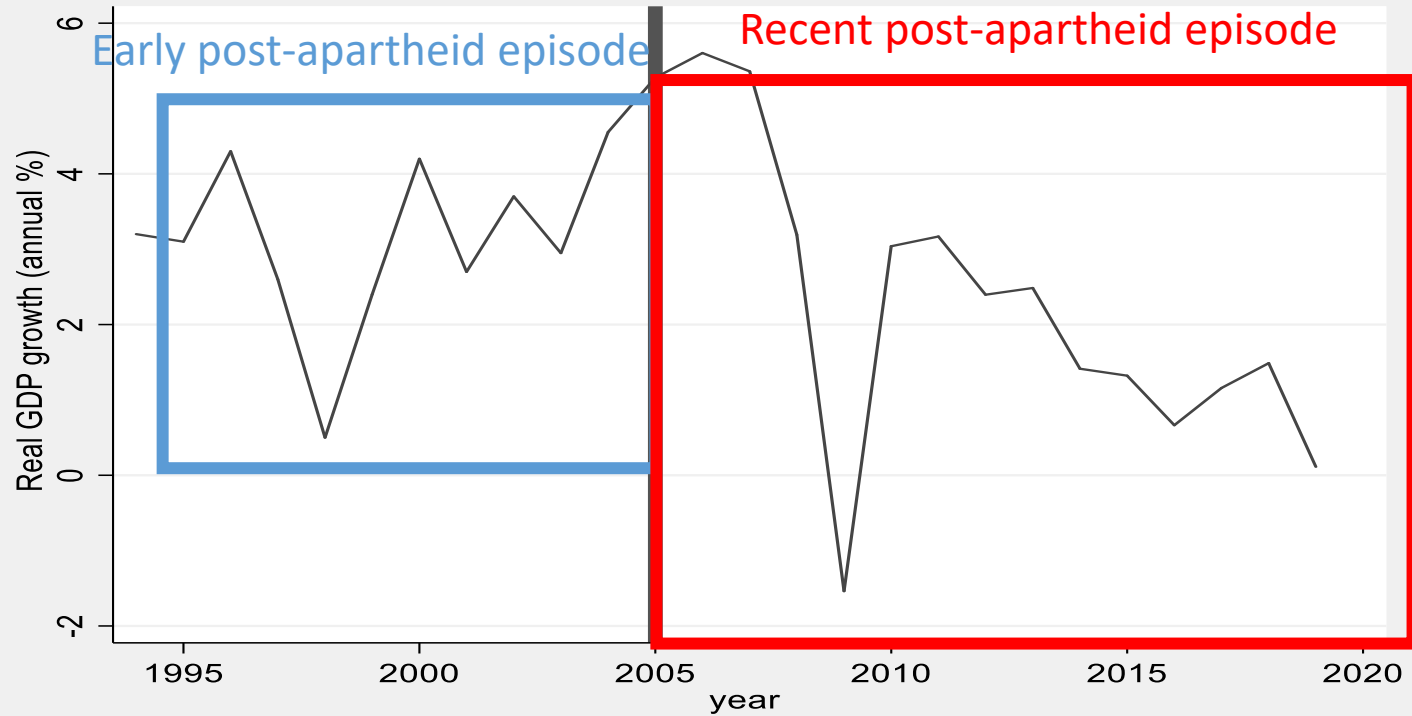
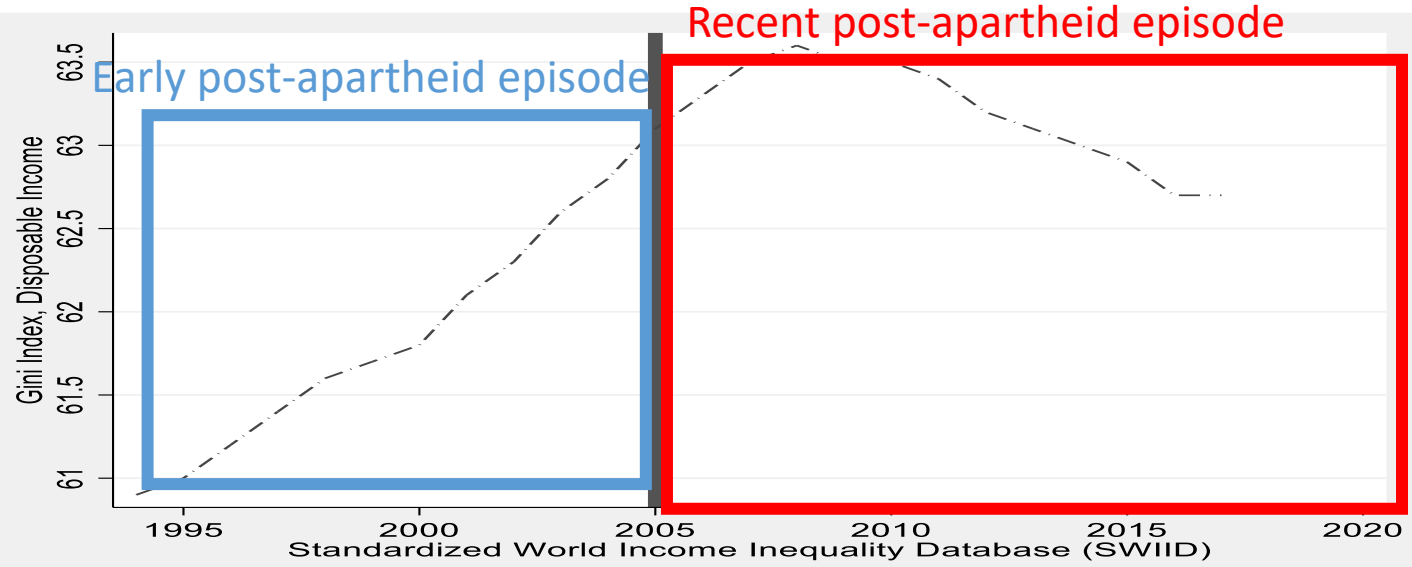


## Income inequality

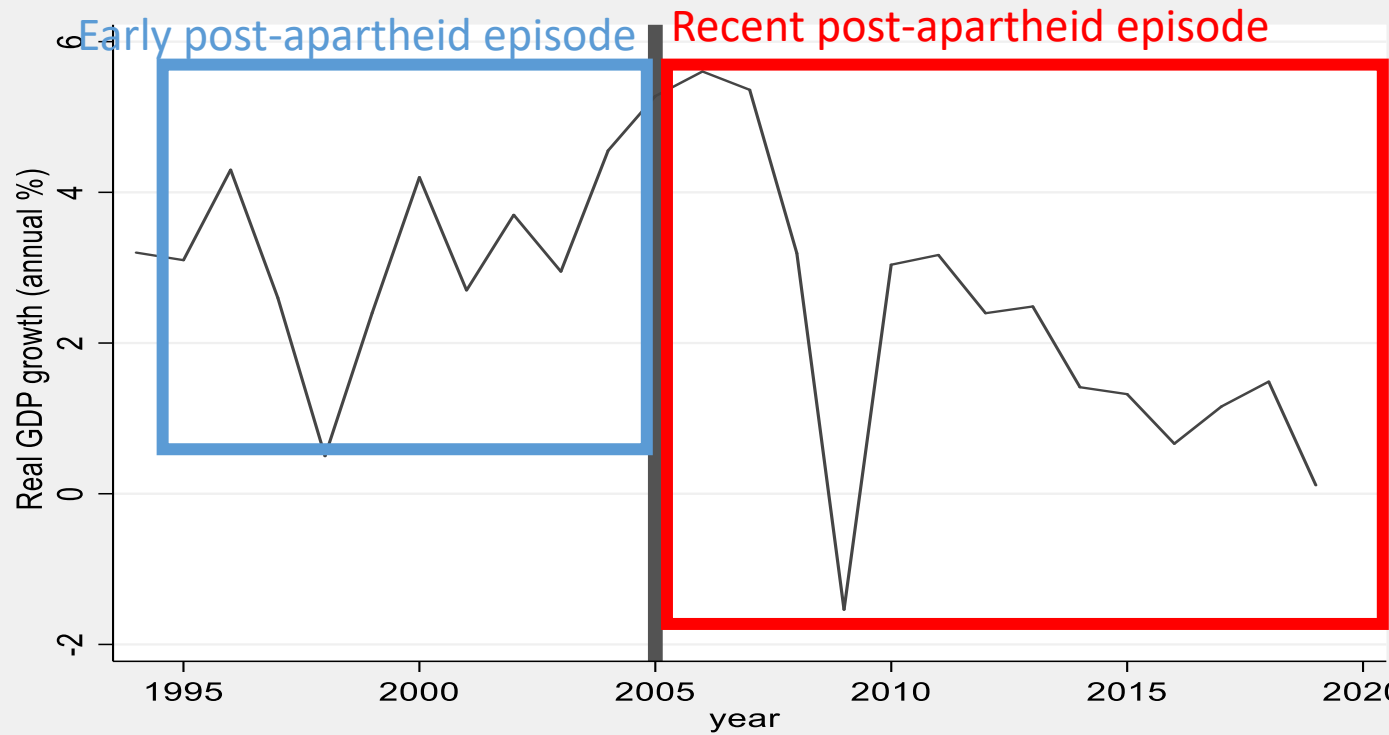
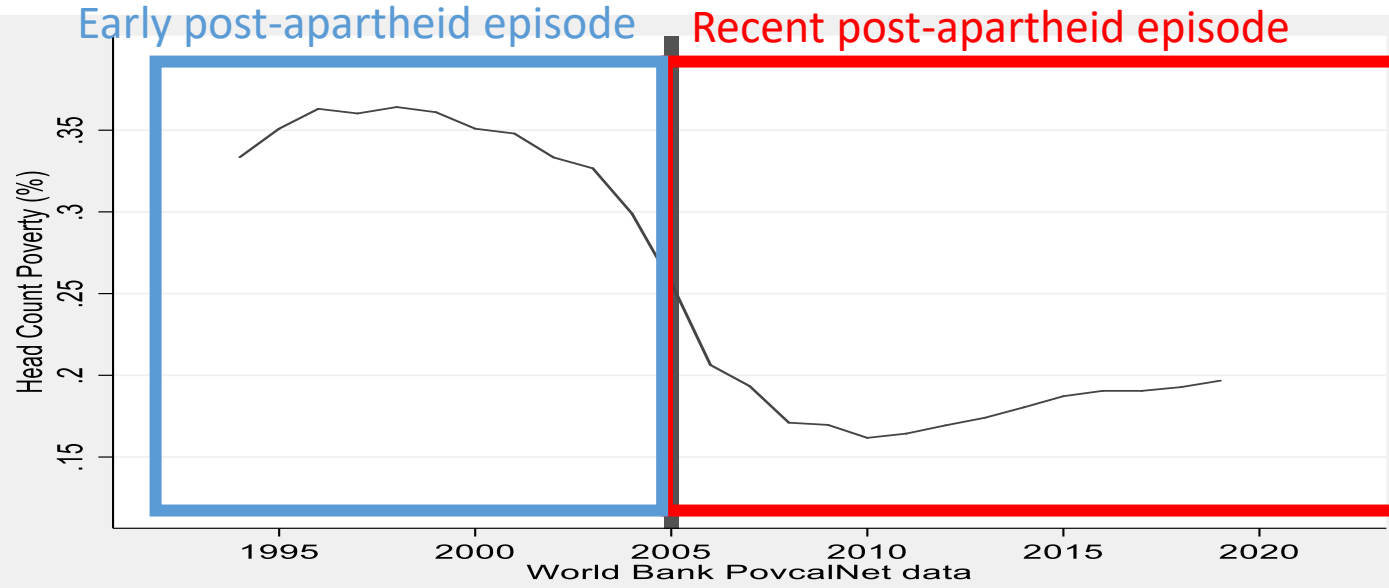

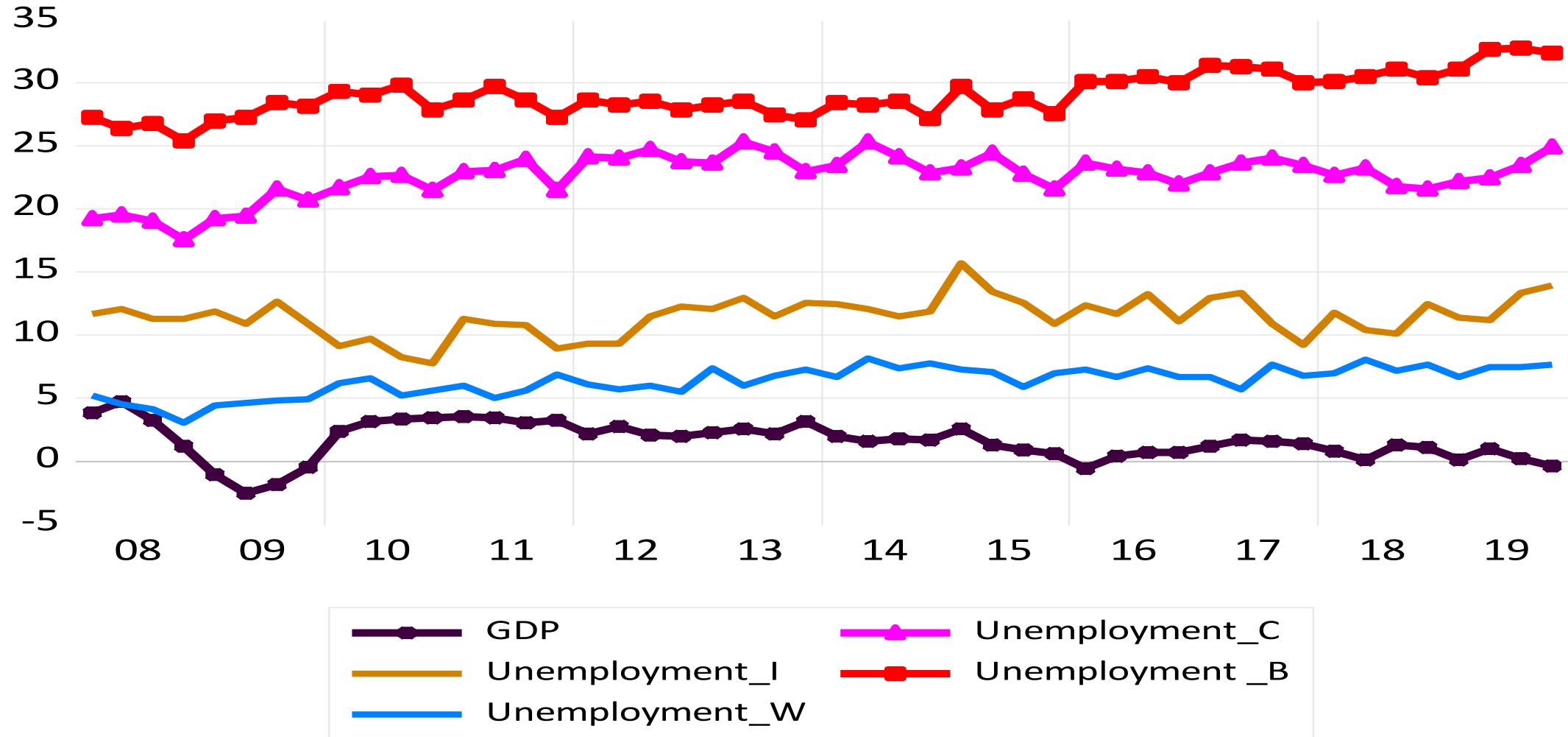
# GDP and poverty rate in SA
